Pack-A-Bag Project 2018

To motivate and encourage the poor and needy children studying in Government schools located in remote areas, we conduct this project every year in selected schools. For this academic year we have selected Government High School and Government Higher Primary School located at Kadusonnappanahalli, Kannuru Post, Bidarahalli Hobli, Bengaluru East Taluk. We started to raise funds among our donors, colleagues and friends in closer circles to support at least 100 children.

We had to change our plan later as the Headmaster of Government High School, Kadusonnappanahalli, has requested us to support all the 210 children in his school as every child is in needy situation. We were amazed to see his concern for his school children and explained about our budget constraints. After a long discussion we took that as a challenge to meet the needs of all the children in that school from classes 8th to 10th Standard, with packages of notebooks and we had to provide them without the school-bag and stationaries due to our budget limitations. The Headmistress of Higher Primary school has given us a list of 45 children from classes 1st to 7th standards.

We took the first 3 weekends of June to negotiate, purchase, transport and pack the materials from wholesale vendors of bags, notebooks and stationery materials. On 30th of June 2018, we organized the events in both schools. Mr. A.S.Ganesh, Headmaster preceded the program in the high school at 8.45 AM. Mrs. Rajamani, Headmistress and her team have organized the program in the Higher Primary school at 10.30 AM. From FAMIN team, Ramesh Kumar, Vijayakumar, Reuben, Jyothi, Nagarjuna, Anu Augustine, Anugya and Mainak Das have participated in transporting, organizing and distributing the items.

The items were distributed to the children in each location after delivering a short motivational speech by the FAMIN team members. They highlighted 3 major points in their speech such as, (1) the importance of having a goal for future and working towards the goal every day, (2) being respectful citizens towards parents, teachers and society, (3) and to help others in need when they grow up in society.

The children, Headmasters and teachers have appreciated the objectives of the program and conveyed their sincere thanks to all the donors, volunteers and FAMIN team for organizing these events and bringing the help to the students.
