During March 2019, FAMIN provided support to a community health clinic at BK Halli, located near to Bagalur Village, Bangalore District. This clinic is run by Mr. Jesudoss and his wife Paulrani to bring medical services to the rural people by providing diagnosis, awareness and treatment for common and specific ailments. We provided medicines for basic ailments, equipments for preliminary diagnosis and furniture for patients-care.

FAMIN provided them with the sets of black and white shoes including pairs of socks. Pack-a-bag 2018

To motivate and encourage the needy children who are studying in Government schools in outer Bangalore, we started this 'Pack-a-bag' project. During June 2018, we conducted a big program to distribute school bags with notebooks, geometry boxes, cover sheets, lables, pencil boxes with stationeries. 45 children from 1st to 7th Standards, studying in Kadusonnappanahalli Higher Primary School have received school bags. 210 children from 8th to 10th Standard have received packs of notebooks and stationaries. The heads of these institutions have conveyed their thanks to everyone involved in this initiative.
